COMMON NAME – Crow

SCIENTIFIC NAME – *Corvus brachyrhynchos* (American Crow)

DESCRIPTION –

- Length – Avg. 46 cm
- Total black coloring
- An American Crow's black feathers are iridescent

RANGE/HABITAT –

- North America from Central Canada to Northern Mexico
- Varies from farmland, parks, woodlands, and urban landscapes
- Some birds will migrate a short distance south, but many don't move from their home

DIET –

- Omnivorous
- Carrion, fish, mice, frogs
- Seeds, grains (preferred), nuts, acorns (especially in winter)

FACTS -

- Crows in captivity can live up to 30 years
- Crows choose single mates and pairs form large families that remain together for years
- Crows are very susceptible to West Nile Virus and some estimate their population has dropped 45% since 1999 due to the virus
